The goal of the Alliance is to look at technology developments on a holistic level and engage a broad range of relevant actors, to strengthen social cohesion in Europe. The EuroTeQ Campus will thus not be restricted to students enrolled at the respective partner institutions, but promote

lifelong learning opportunities to engineers in the workforce, and integrate vocational trainees in technical careers. With individually designed curricula and new digital formats, EuroTeQ promotes an open European university that fosters the mutual understanding between all stakeholders responsible for collaborative technology driven value creation. Together with 45 cooperation partners from industry, trade associations and various areas of society, EuroTeQ aims to explore the great challenges of the 21st century and to jointly formulate solution strategies.

ACCOMPANYING NATIONAL PROGRAMME

Priorities and Project Activities

- Strategic development of the EuroTeQ Engineering University and continuous exchange of best practices in **academic affairs**, accompanied by **project management**, **governance**, **communication**.
- Virtual workshops of EuroTech Chief Information Officers (CIOs) laying the basis for a future **digital campus management system** for the EuroTeQ Campus, integrating the European Student Card.
- Piloting first digital teaching formats, student teams participating in **hackathons**, **digital innovation sprints**, and entrepreneurship programs at the partner universities, developing **virtual challenges** in the EuroTech Focus Areas. Designing a concept for sharing and evaluating digital courses for Alliance partners and **virtual mobility** across the network.
- Co-creation workshops** with local cooperation partners from industry, engineering chambers and various societal stakeholders.

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
